Online Proctor Exam Important Exam Instructions: -

- 1. Study properly and be confident while attempting the Online Examination.
- 2. Ensure that the place from where you will be attempting your examination is quiet and comfortable and has **minimum disturbances/ distractions**.
- 3. Take online MCQ tests or quizzes that are freely available for getting used to the format.
- **4. Attempt all Mock Examinations** held by the College to get familiar with the technical procedure.
- 5. Ensure to have a device (Laptop / Desktop PC/ Tablet / Smartphone) with an inbuilt / external working Camera.
- 6. Ensure to have an active, stable and high-speed Internet Connectivity. You should have sufficient data in Fair Usage Policy (FUP) / Internet plan with sufficient data pack. If using mobile phone, it should be in minimum 3G (4G desirable) coverage with at least 500 MB balance data.
- 7. Giving examination on Laptop or Desktop is highly recommended. Practice using the same Laptop / Desktop PC/ Tablet / Smartphone that you will be using for attempting the Online Examination. Use the same device for the Mock and for the Actual Examinations.
- 8. Calculator is not allowed.
- **9.** Rough sheets are allowed. Please have enough rough sheets by your side, during exam you are not allowed to deviate from your seats.
- **10.** Your exam is **proctored by a live proctor**. The proctor may terminate your exam in case he/she observes any malpractice during the exam.
- 11. Use of headphones and mobiles isn't permissible during the exam.
- 12. Each correct answer has a credit of 1 Mark and there is no negative marking.
- 13. The time duration for the exam is 60 Minutes.
- 14. No breaks are allowed during the exam.
- **15.** Keep your device **started up and fully charged before the examination begins**. Power bank for mobile or UPS/Inverter for laptop/desktop should be available for uninterrupted power supply.
- **16.** Use **web browser such as Mozilla and Chrome browsers** etc. on a desktop/laptop/tab/smart phone.
- **17. Clear browser cache** memory on mobile and laptops. Clear browsing history and also delete temp files.
- **18. Turn off / mute all other apps and notifications** that may interfere with the Online Examination process.
- 19. To avoid unwanted pop-ups, use of Ad Blocker is recommended.
- 20. Close all browsers/tabs before starting the Test.
- 21. Read examination instructions carefully and follow them properly.
- **22.** In any case for **the late joining of examination student** will not get any grace period.
- 23. The same username / password should be used on all days of the Mock and Actual Examinations.
- **24.** Allow camera access and let the software click your photograph. Unless this step is completed, you will not be able to access the test
- **25.** Do not move away from your seat or cover / hide your face from the camera during the entire test. The camera will record all your activities.

- **26.** Once the **test starts, do not switch to any other window/tab.** On doing so, your attempt may be considered as malpractice and your test may get terminated.
- **27.** Do not take call (cut the call) during the test if you are giving the exam on mobile. This also will be treated as changing the window.
- **28.** Do not use the Back button or Close button / icon to go back to previous page or to close the screen.
- **29. Manage your time properly.** Give approximately equal time for attempting each answer.
- **30.** You can **submit the test before timer expires.** If timer expires, test will be submitted **automatically.**
