PRINCIPAL'S ANNUAL REPORT

Smt. MMK College is an institution with a passion for knowledge. We are an academic interdisciplinary, research and creative activity-driven college. We are constantly evolving and impacting the lives of young students in a positive way by offering a variety of activities and skill-based certificate courses along with traditional courses. “Student first” is the principle which every staff is imbibed off. The college has completed its diamond jubilee (60th year) with lots of pomp and glory. The college is a premier institution in the city of Mumbai, providing excellence in education at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels in the fields of Commerce and Economics, with specialization in Accountancy, Management, International Business and other emerging areas. The college has a range of programme options and courses relevant to the local needs and in tune with the emerging national and global trends. The institution with around 4,500 students on roll, has made rapid strides in diverse fields and grown from being an undergraduate college providing education up to doctoral level.

Research Centre: The College has started research centers to provide doctoral degree in Commerce-Business Policy and Administration and Accountancy.

NAAC Reaccreditation: It has been reaccredited with “A” grade by NAAC in the third cycle in May 2017. NAAC reaccreditation process has started for the 4th cycle.

Preparing towards NEP-Autonomy: A very significant move made this year was the decision to apply for Autonomy. After the several rounds of the meetings with Management and other stakeholders, the college is embarking on the journey of autonomous status and adding another feather in its cap. In this process, the Report has already been submitted to Mumbai University and forwarded to UGC, Delhi. Now the college is eagerly awaiting the visit of the Team of Experts which is expected soon in near future. The College as a team has been working earnestly and doing all the preparation in this regard.

MMK Experience: The College not only aims to enrich the academic journey, but also provides an environment to explore and discover the true potential. Understanding the need to prepare students beyond academic excellence, we have constituted the 'MMK Experience' – which entails a series of workshops/programmes that aspire to build students' self-confidence, creativity and entrepreneur skills. It has been our constant endeavour to prepare future graduates and postgraduates for global challenges who could make a meaningful difference in the society hence the college has developed strong linkages with prestigious institutes like ICAI and BMA wherein student centric seminars and workshops are organized on a continual basis.

Social outreach: To enhance students' learning opportunities and experiences, the college organizes a myriad of activities. The college believes in personality development by incorporating values and life skills. We strive to impart education which suits the needs of business and industry, where fulfilling social responsibility is being increasingly recognized as crucial for the progress of society. With this aim, we have been undertaking outreach activities through NSS, DLLE, Rotaract and various field activities organized by both regular and self-financing courses.

Smt.M.M.K.College is also following that spirit of Amrit Mahotsav that is elixir of new ideas, elixir of Aatmanirbhar Bharat. The college will be organizing a series of events to commemorate the 75th Anniversary of India's independence. The Mahotsav will be celebrated in the college in its true spirit. Cultural committee is fully involved in it.

Karavaan 2022, the first inter-collegiate fest by BAMMC Department, Fineco Club, an initiative by BMS and BFM Department are other benchmark events of the college.

Admissions: The number of seats for admission at FYBCom were increased and more students were accommodated this year.

We started with Three Vocational courses and the numbers of student who have taken admission to these courses have doubled this year.

The College reopened in offline mode and several vaccination drives were initiated where students were encouraged to complete their doses of Vaccination.

The Sindhi Department: It was formed in our college in 2006.From then, we have been constantly striving to revive the Sindhi language by conducting certificate, diploma and advance diploma courses of NCPSL. We also conduct orientation programmes, seminars and workshops on various occasions. Our Sindhi students have been participating in various intercollegiate competitions. Every year, the Sindhi department takes initiative to observe the 'Moment of calm'- Forgiveness advocated by Sadhu Vaswani Mission.

Completion of 60th year: The year was also filled with a variety of programmes, guest lectures and activities as part of the grand celebrations of the 60th year of our college. More than 60 wonderful events were planned and executed meticulously using both online and offline modes.

Our College Placement Cell: - Our College has been working hard towards developing good industry – academia relations to ensure placements of students in reputed organization. Reputed companies have come on campus and selected our students for fulltime placements. Our placement process is ongoing and we are proud to say that we have not only placed a lot of students but students who were helped with internships have also converted those internships into to fulltime jobs.

College Library : The college library is enriched with a collection of more than 51,000 books and 52 journals and e-resources. It provides a book bank facility to needy B.Com students. The college library conducted an orientation programme for students at the beginning of the academic year. The college library publishes an E-library bulletin periodically to update users about library activities.

It is also the endeavour of our HSNC Board to be at the forefront of human knowledge and work towards the fulfillment of cultural, scientific, intellectual and humane needs of society in general and students in particular.

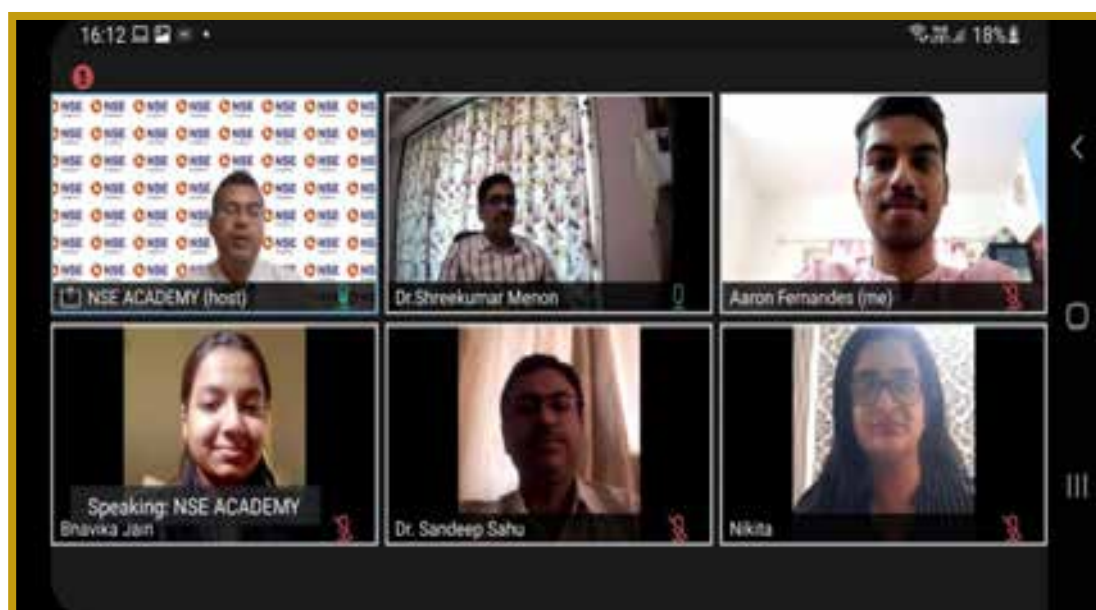
Webinar on National live stock trading contest 'TRADE-A-THON & Investing via Mutual Funds'

Train. Earn. Learn Course

The Train.Earn. Learn (TEL) course was conducted in collaboration with WIRC of The Indian Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) between 10th January, 2022 to 24th January, 2022 on the online platform BlueJeans. The course was an intensive 36 hours course spending 3 hours on each of the 12 days by highly qualified and experienced Chartered Accountants. The main aim of the course was to teach soft skills such as Business Communication, Personality Development, Social and Business Etiquette along with practical skills such as E-filing of Income tax Returns, GST, Knowledge of Excel, Tally and TDS under Income Tax.

Following completion of the course the students were required to give an exam and pass which certificates were issued by Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). An added benefit of the course was that students were given an opportunity to apply for internships in CA firms to get a hands-on experience of the skills they learnt. In all 75+ students participated in the program. The course was extremely beneficial for the students as they learnt not just with theory-based lectures but were also given Case studies to work along with and various other activities so as the student would get to apply their skill in a practical way.

A summary of the 12 days is given below:

Day 1 – Personality Development
Date – 10th January, 2022
Speaker – CA Jyoti Malkani

The very first session was on Personality Development where students were given ways in which they could build their personality through hard work, defining their area of excellence, improving their body language, etc. Ways in which one can build their brand through being authentic and genuine in their approach, being consistent and using various platforms to be in the area of the niche were also discussed.

Students downloaded the TallyPrime software to practice how to create Masters, Stock Groups, Stock Units, etc. Creating various Vouchers along with entering the data as well as altering the data to make changes were also discussed.

Day 2 – Personality Development

Date – 11th January, 2022

Speaker – CA Sharda Sunder

The second session was Business Communication where students were taught effective verbal communication and Non-verbal Communication. Verbal Communication consisted of how to be an active listener in order to overcome the barriers to Effective Communication. Students were also taught how they should communicate on various platforms such as phone, Skype, Email, etc. in order to create a good impact. Non-verbal Communication was all about how one should improve their body language, gestures etc. Tips on how one can build their personality and brand were also given.

Day 3 – Social and Business Etiquette

Date – 12th January, 2022

Speaker – Dr. CA Prakash Valecha

The third session was of Social and Business Etiquettes where students were taught how the very first impression matters and how one must present themselves in various environments such as in meetings, interviews, while dining etc. How one must present themselves online as well as on telephonic conversations were also discussed. The students were also given an opportunity to form groups in order to make presentations on etiquettes of various countries in their respective environment.

Day 4 & Day 5 – E-filing under Income Tax

Dates – 13th January, 2022 & 14th January, 2022

The fourth and fifth sessions were of acquiring knowledge of how to file Income Tax Returns on the Income tax portal. The students were taught from the very basics of Income tax such as who is an assessor, the various sources of Income, Deductions, etc., to more practical concepts such tax payments, return of income etc. Students were also given a hands-on practice of downloading an IT form to fill to apply the knowledge they gained in the 2 days.

Day 6 & Day 7 – GST

Dates – 17th January, 2022 & 18th January, 2022

Speaker – CA Rupal Haria

The sixth and seventh session was all about GST where students were taught from the very basics about the Classification of Goods and Services, Scope of Supply, the various types of GST applicable, benefits of GST, RCM, Input Tax Credit (ITC), etc. Registration on the GST Portal along with the various forms that need to be filed were also discussed. The sessions were filled with various Case Studies to apply the knowledge gained.

Day 8 & Day 9 – Knowledge of Excel – Audit Tools & Analysis

Dates – 19th January, 2022 & 20th January, 2022

The eighth and ninth sessions were on the Basics of Excel to Advanced concepts such as Pivot Tables, graphs and data entry, etc. The students were provided with various files where they could practice the concepts. 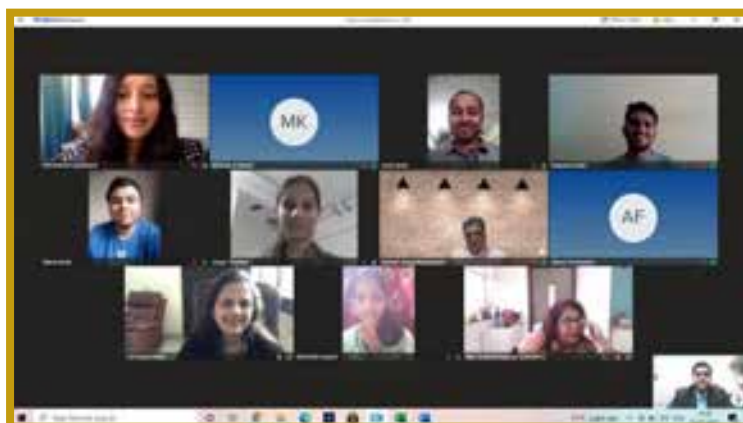

DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ECONOMICS

Academics: All classes for FYBCOM, SYBCOM, TYBCOM, and MCOM were conducted online through the MS-Teams Platform purchased by the college for online delivery of lectures. Report on Three Days' Workshop On 'Copywriting and Campaign Analysis Tools – Building Blocks to Digital Marketing' (15th – 17th July 2021)

Smt. MMK College of Commerce & Economics conducted a three days' workshop on ***“Copywriting and Campaign Analysis Tools – Building Blocks to Digital Marketing”*** from 15th to 17th July 2021. This was conducted as a joint initiative by the Department of Business Management and Department of Bachelors in Mass Media & Communication of the College. Each session was of two hours between 3pm to 5pm. The Resource person were persons of eminence in their respective fields.

The FDP was inaugurated by the Principal Dr. CA Kishore Peshori. Vice Principal Mrs. Asha Bhatt, Golden Jubilee coordinator Dr. Vishal Tomar, Mr. Shrinivas Aiyar, Dr. Sandeep Sahu including student coordinators Mr. Sevansh Gupta, Ms. Gauri Gopale, Ms. Qureshi Sauda and Mr. Garvit along with 66 attended the sessions. As it was designed, as a paid workshop, the college collected nominal fees of Rs 50 per participant. First day of the session started with the prayer to 'Saraswati Vandana' in keeping up with the tradition of our college. Then, the Resource person took the platform and started the session on the topic of copywriting elements like USP, Big Idea. She explained the techniques of Copywriting, Career and professional opportunities in the field and then, Evaluation of some digital advertising and Social Media Ads were explained.

Then she shared her personal experience of a wooden toy company. A doubt clearing session was conducted and the students were answered for their queries. She gave tips to the students on how to follow favorite commercial pages & check how often the ads should be posted.

An Activity at 4:30 pm was given to students about a presentation for one product of their choice and get it reviewed. After the activity Question and Answer session was held where doubts of the participants were clarified. The second day of the workshop was on 16th July. That was the day of assignment where participants were asked to work on the following series.

- Give brief outline of brand of specific product or service to be advertised Identify USP 4 Outline a Big Idea for a digital campaign.
- Create 7 post as a part of digital campaign for brands social media platform Write content for brand's website, online portal, SMS and direct mails,

The third day was on 17th July 2021 the Resource person was an alumnus of MMK College Mr. Huzaifa Amin Merchant. Resource person was quite happy and excited about being in MMK once again. The topics for 17th July was Digital Media Space, impact of digital India to Ad, how to create target audience, Power of

Google, Facebook, case study which are media led, Email marketing and how to generate Strategic Insights He started with a presentation on the topics of the session. He asked questions to the students and students wisely answered him. IQAC- 2021-22

"One of the most powerful tools for empowering individuals and communities is making certain that any individual who wants to receive a quality education can do so." - Christine Gregoire

As we continued our journey, despite the ongoing challenges posed by the pandemic, several new benchmarks and milestones were set towards paving the path for quality enhancement and sustenance to provide a better future for the generations to come.

A very significant move made this year was the decision to apply for Autonomy this year. On 12th October 2021, our Principal invited Dr. Vinay Bhole, Consultant for Autonomy, for a meeting with the IQAC core committee. He briefed the committee on the modalities of the Autonomy process and solved the queries of the staff.

A presentation was made before the Management by the IQAC coordinator, Ms. Chippy Susan B and the team led by the Principal, on the need and importance for going for Autonomy. This was followed by team visits by Staff members to four major Autonomous colleges. A detailed report of these visits was also sent to the Management. The work for Autonomy continued and the Proposal was prepared and sent to the University and UGC, followed by departmental and personal presentations.

The year was also filled with a variety of programmes, guest lectures and activities as part of the grand celebrations of the 60th year of our college. More than 60 wonderful events were planned and executed meticulously using both online and offline modes.

FDP:- An FDP on Strategies, Tools and Techniques for Online Teaching, Learning and Evaluation was conducted from 9th -14th August 2021. This FDP was organized by St. Francis Institute of Management and Research and Smt. Mithibai Motiram Kundnani College of Commerce and Economics. It was a six days programme with sessions lasting for two hours every day. This FDP was organized with the following objectives -

- A) to create awareness among teachers of various online tools and techniques
- B) to develop online skills and application of those skills
- C) to enhance receptivity of students
- D) Co-curricular and extracurricular activities through online tools
- E) To find simple ways to conduct exams and evaluation.

The programme commenced at 4 pm with the college Anthem being sung by students. The inaugural address was given by Dr. D. Henry, Director of SFMAR who welcomed all the participants. He explained the need for such a topical workshop, where it has become imperative for educators to master various online teaching tools.

- F) In the virtual classrooms, student interaction is a big challenge, critical thinking has also taken a backseat, social and emotional bonding have been affected. He reiterated that it was the need of the hour to address these challenges.

Conduct Of Examinations Through Google Auto Proctoring - Day One

Dr. Natika Podar introduced the Resource person for the day, Dr. Mandar Bhanushe ,Head, Faculty of Science and Technology, IDOL, University of Mumbai.

The topic of the session was conduct of examinations through Google auto proctoring. He started by introducing this software solution for the conduct of examinations in a smooth manner.

Auto proctor can be used for Google forms And Microsoft forms.

He also explained about fully automated test proctoring .Google auto proctor is an artificial intelligence powered remote proctoring software. It is an automated proctoring solution for online tests. As users take tests, it monitors the users' environment and actions, real time to determine malpractice.

He then explained how the auto proctor functions. The timer feature and the possibility of integration with Google forms, video tutorials, Microsoft forms and LMS makes it a very useful tool for conducting exams. It also gives the trust score at the end of the test. It can also handle thousands of simultaneous users and multiple teacher logins.

An auto proctor demo test was conducted for the participants towards the end of the session. Dr. Natika Podar summed up the day's session by highlighting the benefits of using auto proctor and concluded that it is a very economical and easy way of conducting exams through machine proctoring. The session ended with feedback and vote of thanks.

DAY2 -

Flipped classroom and E - content development

The Resource Person for this session was Mr. Parteek Bhatia , Professor at TIET, Patiala. He conducted the session on flip classroom and e content development. He emphasized the need for online education in the covid-19 situation. Since online education has become a norm, teachers and students emerge as winners in this era of blended learning and flipped learning therefore the need for flipped classrooms.

It is observed that in the real classroom, the teacher ends up using maximum brain than the student. In the flipped classroom there is a reverse of the teaching style, where the teachers spend more time interacting with the students. Before coming to the class the students will learn the basics by using teacher created videos and then the classroom time will be used to solve problems so in the flip mode the teacher is on the side as a facilitator. He also give examples of flipped classroom from University of Texas.

What is flipped learning model? How is it different from traditional method and how can we implement it in our class Why is it important to record our own content how you can create your own video session how we can launch our YouTube channel how we can launch our own MOOCS.

Menti.com :-A quiz was given at the beginning on mentimeter .He asked participants if they have their own YouTube channel.

The advantages of a flip class are many.

- The student can review the videos.
- The time in the class becomes more interactive and hands on training happens.
- This is a powerful tool for those who miss class.
- The course content can be archived.
- Students can be kept engaged and there is a more personalized learning.

It force so changes the way that the teachers talk to parents about the children unexplained how we can have our own video session and provide our own video content.

The student is then supposed to watch the video before each class the teacher can start each class with questions discussions and pop up quizzes. The teacher can also make use of notes outline, discussion forum, reflective blogging, and partner students for review and make them accountable, use real-time feedback with multimeter.

Mr. Bhatia then explained about the massive open online course. He highlighted the benefits of recording lectures.

The session ended with his teaching on how to record videos using Adobe presenter and similar tools for video recording. Overall, it was a very beneficial session for the participants.

DAY3-

'Online Teaching-Learning Pedagogy'

As part of the FDP held between 9th – 14th August 2021, a session on 'Online Teaching-Learning Pedagogy' was held on 11th Aug 2021. The speaker Mr. Mandar Bhanushe, enlightened the participants on the need to modify the teaching learning pedagogy in an online mode, since the methods that were used for offline teaching could not be replicated in an online mode, hence there was a need to have a different approach on case of online teaching. He discussed the challenges faced by teachers in both the offline and online mode and how these challenges also differed.

He recognized that the sudden requirement for shifting from offline to online teaching was indeed a challenge for the teaching community, but suggested certain methods that could be used to overcome the situation. In order to transform information into knowledge for the students in the online mode, he suggested the need for 'technological intervention'. The role of the teacher was fast changing from just merely teaching to now facilitating as lectures needed to be more 'learner-centered' through the use of technology. Activity based teaching was another method that would immensely help the students.

He emphasized the need for increasing student engagement in class by introducing collaborative learning, use of discussion forums, providing them incentives, continuous evaluation, trying and identifying behavioral issues and understanding the preparedness of students for online learning.

In order to effectively bring about the transformation from information into knowledge he emphasized the need of technological intervention and suggested the use of apps such as Pear Deck. He explained the working of the app demonstrated its use. The app is an interactive presentation tool that can be used to engage students in individual and social learning.

Teachers create their presentations using their Google Drive account. The benefit of the app was that it combined presentations along with interactive questions to enhance student–teacher engagement.

The session was well-received by the attendees, as they learnt how technology can be effectively used to enhance learning experience for students.

DAY4-

Collaborative Learning & LMS

As part of the FDP held between 9th – 14th August 2021, a session on 'Collaborative Learning and LMS' was held on 12th Aug 2021. The speaker Mr Ritesh Kumar, enlightened the participants on the need for collaborative learning through peer to peer groups. Collaborative learning is important for creating educational experiences that are active, contextually engaging and will lead to Deeper Learning.

It is important to develop higher level thinking. Increasing student retention, preparation for real life social and employment situations among the students. To use collaborative learning, it is important to establish ground rules for participation and contributions, help students develop the skills of team-building or self-reflection. In order to introduce collaborative learning, it is important to first introduce the task and provide enough time to engage with the task.

He introduced the 'Padlet' app that could be used for Learning Management Systems. Easy to use, with number of options. It can be used for quick engagement with the students and works for all modes of delivery. It also acts as a gap filler between more formal tools. It can be used both by teachers and students to post common notes and work collaboratively by choosing various formats such as Walls, Grids, Stream, Shelf, Maps, Timeline and Canvas.

These Learning Management Systems could help in delivering online training courses and enroll and monitor the audiences. He further went on to explain the use of the LMS solutions by various entities such as business organizations as well as educational institutions. He also demonstrated the use of the EDMODO app which was freely available.

A very informative session, wherein the speaker introduces novel ways of enhancing student learning experience.

Strategies, Tools and Techniques for Online Teaching and Learning Evaluation

Various online Quiz and Assimilation tools - DAY 5-Dr G Ramesh

Day 5 of the FDP comprised of practice of different Online Quiz making tools, demonstration of select tools on developing the online quiz and hands on exercises of the same.

Various tools for conducting these assimilation tools which were discussed in the session were, ProProf, MS Teams Forms, Hot Potatoes, Panquiz, Mentimeter, Quizziz, Quiz Maker and Typeform.

The Speaker took the audience through all these platforms and helped them navigate through the software. Sample quiz exercises were also shown to the participants.

The participants were also given hands-on training and 10 minutes were given to prepare any one or two tools which were discussed.

It was a very application oriented and practically useful session for all the participants.

Testmoz and Wakelet -Online Evaluation Tool

Dr. Natika Poddar - DAY 6

The Speaker took the participants through Testmoz and Wakelet.

Testmoz is a very useful tool for all as it easily creates tests for any class, business or organization, distribute the tests online and get the results instantly. It also does the entire grading hence making it absolutely essential for teachers.

Wakelet is a tool that allows users to take control of the content that interests and inspires them. Wakelet users can save content and organize it in folders or wakes (e.g., student portfolios). The teachers and students can curate videos, images, and links.

It was indeed a very enlightening session as online education has become the need of the hour in these pressing times.

The 6 days programme concluded with feedback from participants and concluding remarks from MMK College Principal Dr. CA Kishore Peshori. Overall, it was a very fruitful and engaging programme, with participants getting to learn about many new online tools in this era of online education.

The Third Faculty Development Programme conducted by WIRC of ICAI in collaboration with Mumbai University, HSNC University, IAA and Smt. MMK College covered topics related to Research Process and Technology Trends. The virtual FDP was held on 25th June, between 10 am to 1 pm.

Principal Dr. CA. Kishore S. Peshori, Smt. MMK College of Commerce and Economics presented opening remarks by giving a brief about the FDP. He emphasized on the importance of academic research for educators, which is also one of the focus areas of The New Education Policy. He specified that the FDP which is a collaborative effort with WIRC, Universities and Colleges aims to create awareness about the importance of research as a means for developing analytical and creative thinking abilities. He informed that Smt. MMK College is celebrating its 60th Year and as part of its Diamond Jubilee Celebrations, it is organizing an Elocution Competition and Quiz Contest for students on 1st July to commemorate the CA foundation day and the GST day.

Dr. Nishikant Jha, Secretary General, Indian Accounting Association reiterated the importance of research. He mentioned that several Multi-National Corporations have created a huge market base for them and reached greater heights by focusing on research. Research has a great potential to contribute to the society but still there is a long way to go. He spoke about celebrating the CA and the GST Day on 1st July as a collaborative effort.

The speaker of the first technical session, CA Dr. Vardharaj Bapat, IITB on “Walkthrough of Research Process in conducting contemporary research in Accounting and Finance” explained the process of research and how to enhance its relevance to the economy. He touched upon a comprehensive list of innovative research topics that can be considered in the areas of accountancy and finance. He related the discussion to The New Education Policy that has given a new perspective to research by its thrust on indigenous topics.

CA Manish Gadia, Chairman, WIRC has spoken about the “Train, Learn and Earn” training module which the WIRC has started for the benefit of students and expressed willingness to collaborate with various educational institutions in conducting such activities as also various career counseling sessions. It contributes to skill enhancement apart from providing practical training to students.

The second session on “Education Technology Trends 2020-21” was conducted by CA Vikram Pandya, Director, Fintech, S.P. Jain. He emphasized on the necessity to update oneself with new content, new technologies. He has given a practical discourse on new tools that can be used to curate the content and summarize data, explained how such tools can be used in teaching learning atmosphere to enhance learner experience.

The concluding remarks were given by the Deputy Director, Ms. Srabani Kapoor of WIRC.

Dada JP Vaswani 103rd birth anniversary programme was organized on 2nd August 2021, which was a day long online programme, attended in full strength by Junior and Degree College staff and Students.

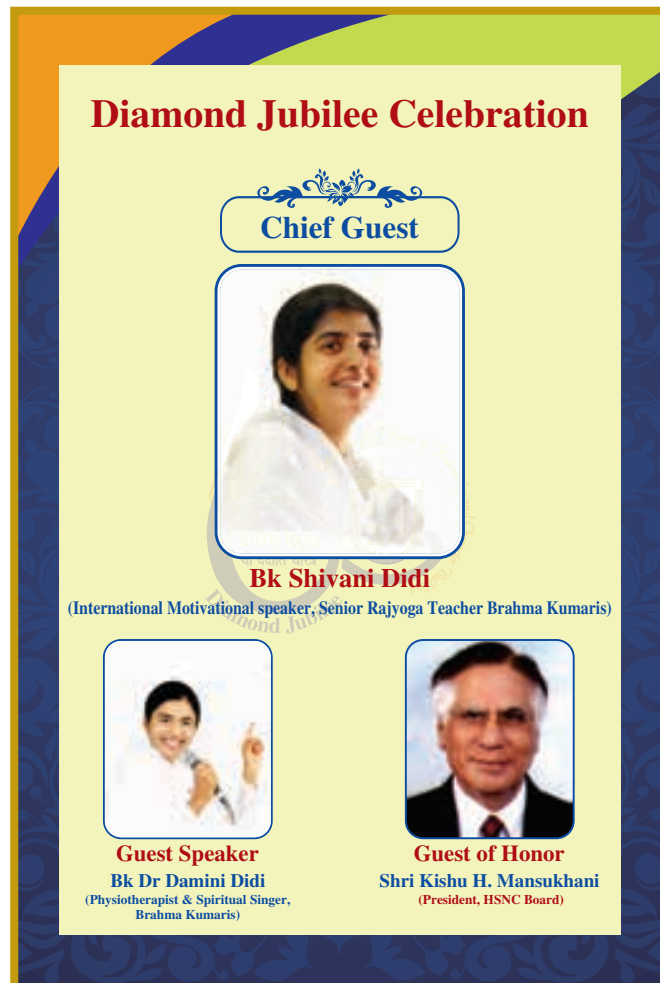

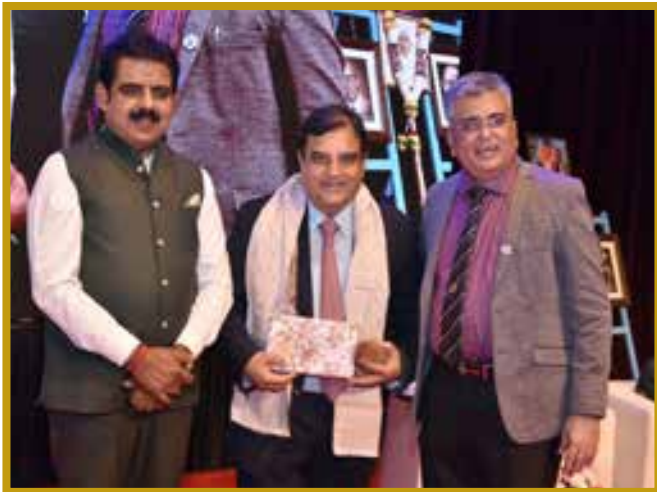

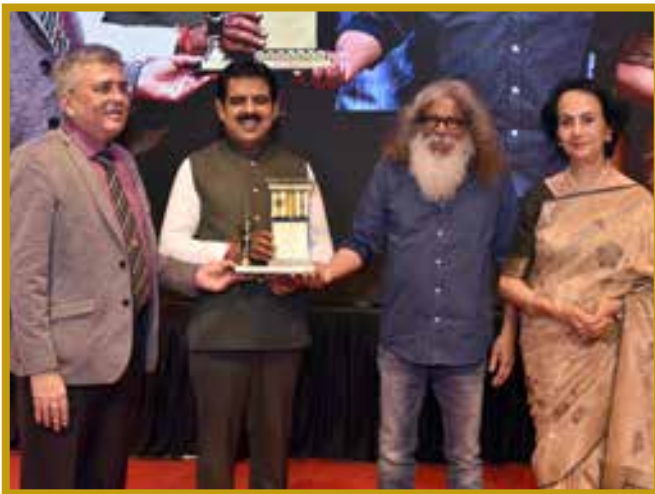
















The Valedictory function of the Diamond Jubilee Celebrations

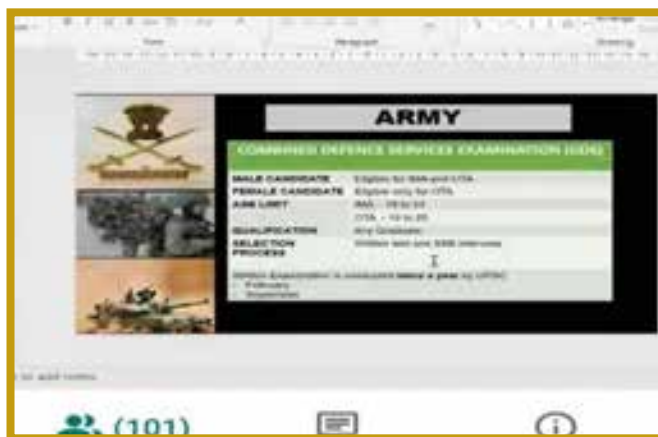
Republic Day (26th January, 2022)

LIBRARY REPORT

Collection Development

The college library subscribed to 197 e-textbooks from Sheth publishers to allow students to access textbooks from home during lockdown. The collection was expanded with 736 books costing Rs.1,55,998/-. The library subscribes to 53 periodicals including e- journals. The library continued to subscribe to NLIST e-resources. The library's digital collection is still being added to the OPAC.

Book Bank Scheme

The library provides a set of textbooks to needy B.Com students for the entire academic year from a book bank scheme. This year, 126 students took advantage of the service. To allow additional students to use the book bank, 90 textbooks costing Rs.11520/- were added to the book bank collection.

Institutional Membership

The College Library has institutional membership of Bombay Management Association, Dosti House (American Library) and Asia Society India Center.

Library Orientation

Students in each course were given an online library orientation and were also introduced to numerous Open Educational Resources at the start of the academic year.

Library Audit

A voluntary Library Audit was held in order to enhance the library system on 29 March 2022. The auditing team members were Dr. Madhuri Tikam, Librarian, H.R. College of Commerce & Economics and Dr. Jayadev H. Kadli, Librarian, Lala Lajpatrai College of Commerce & Economics. The auditing team's recommendations have been integrated into the library.

Special Day Celebrations

On the occasion of Yoga day, 21 June 2021, the library created a virtual Video shelf on Yoga and shared it with students and faculty on their respective WhatsApp groups. The library also created a virtual Classics Bookshelf and shared it with students and faculty on their WhatsApp group during their winter vacation.

Gandhi Jayanti was celebrated in the library by displaying books on and by Gandhi. Books on Sindhi were displayed on the occasion of 'Jyot Sindhiyat Ji', 107th birthday celebration of Late. Jotu Kundnani on 14th Dec. 2021 to enhance the user's knowledge of Sindhi literature and culture.

A Webinar on "Public Speaking Skills"

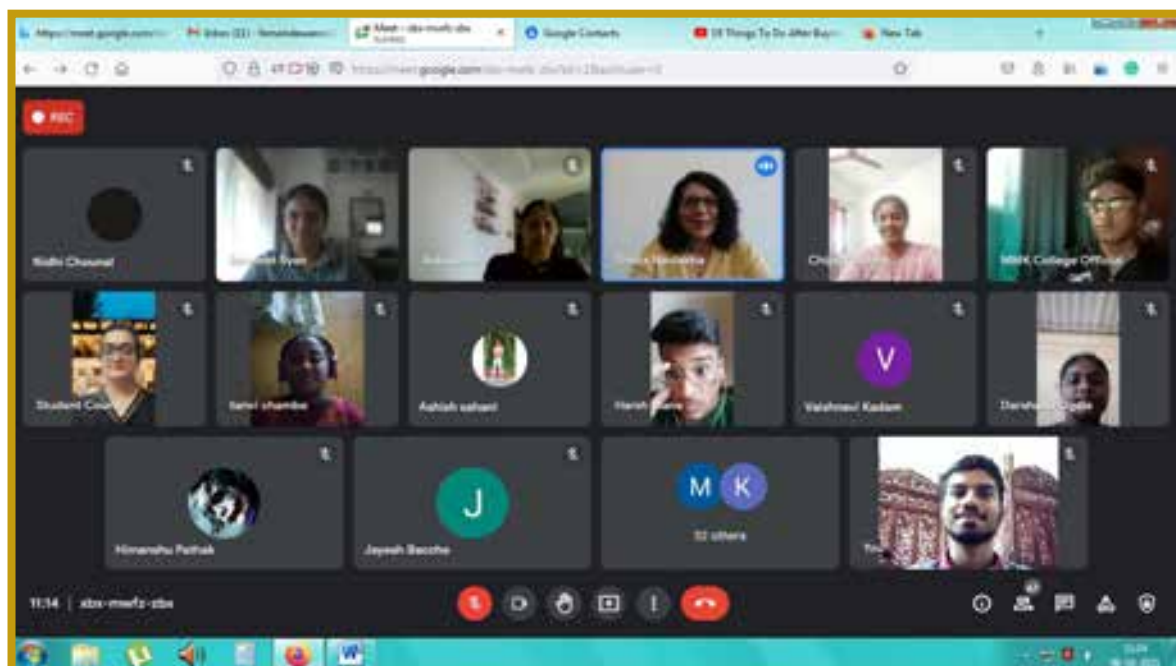
